SECTION I - REQUEST

This is a request to delete the Emissions Technician Certificate program in the Department of Sales & Service Technology (SST) within the College of Applied Science & Technology. The Emissions Technician Certificate is an 18-credit program that prepares individuals to do repairs on failed EI/M vehicles. All of the courses included in this Certificate program are also part of existing associate and bachelor degree offerings within the Automotive Program that is housed within the SST Department.

SECTION II - NEED

There have been no students enrolled in the Emissions Technician program for the past five years, and there is no indication that there will be future student interest in this certificate program. The courses that were included in the Technician program are still offered within the Automotive Program, so any future interested students could still complete the course work. At the end of the 18 credits, they could receive a certificate of completion (vs an institutional certificate).

SECTION III - INSTITUTIONAL IMPACT

The institutional impact of this change is anticipated to be minimal, and includes changes in the catalog and other institutional documents where this certificate is identified.

SECTION IV - FINANCES

Approving the deletion of this certificate is not anticipated to incur substantial costs or savings beyond those associated with the regular updating of documents. All of the courses which were part of the Emissions Technician certificate will continue to be taught since they are part of ongoing Automotive Program degree offerings.
